

#### OFFICIATING AT THE GARDEN STATE GAMES by Vin Godleski, AHAUS Referee-in-Chief

#### QUALITY

As the level of Ice Hockey competition increases the need for quality officials increases. The efforts for the officials to keep pace with players development are as diligent as they are for the players and their coaches.

If the officials (and the teams) are doing a good job you'll never pay much attention to the referee and linesmen. We hope that will be the case again this year. But if you do stop to watch them for a line shift or during a time out you probably won't see the "same old faces".

#### OPPORTUNITY

It has been my policy as Referee-in-Chief of the Atlantic District to use the best, most enthusiastic young officials possible. This has worked out well in the vast majority of the tournament, mid-season and play-off games where we have appointed a junior official in place of a proven veteran.

#### TRAINING

Local and National Camps, Schools and clinics are conducted throughout the season. Every district Official must attend a clinic each year. This gives them an opportunity to brush up on the rules, get in shape and improve their skating. National Summer Camps are held for the top young prospects. The past five seasons the Atlantic District has had as large representation as any AHAUS District.

#### SUPERVISION

Each Tournament game will be attended by a game supervisor as is done in Division 1 college games and the NHL. It is their job to provide effective feed-back to the on-ice officials. They will share their observations with the game officials either between periods or after the game, which ever they judge will be most effective.

The referee on the ice is in full charge and his decisions and actions are final. However, the game Referee-in-Chief's job is to provide an additional resource for the referee if the referee chooses to use him to answer questions, relay directions or help him get things done with the rink crew or teams.

#### COMPETITION

The competition to participate in the Garden State Games is as intense for the officials as it is for the players. Almost since the end of last season a large number of young men have

been training and conditioning for the games.

Several Atlantic District referees participated in the AHAUS National Officials School held at the Olympic Training Center in Lake Placid, NY in mid June. These men were selected in a nation wide competition. Using their new skills and experience gained at these National Camps to work during the games will be:

We'd like you to become one!

'We're looking for a few good people", as the Marines say. If you think you'd like to try being a ref, give us a call. As long as you can skate fairly well and have the players best intersets at heart, you can do it! Come on out!

- 2. Participate in a local clinic

Referee training sessions for beginning and advanced ice hockey officials will be held in 18 locations throughout the district this fall. Prospective new officials, coaches and interested administrators and parents are welcome in addition to all experienced officials.

#### It is important:

- . The rules have not changed this year but you'll get all the changes and the latest interpretations,
- . You will meet the league assigners and improve your chances of getting all your games scheduled early,
- . You will get a jump on completing the Open Book Rules exam and get ready for the Level 4 Closed Book test,
- . Plus it is mandatory for officials to participate in a clinic to be registered and eligible to be assigned games.

Dates are still approximate until ice time can be scheduled. Check with the area supervisor nearest you or Hockey Central 215-389-9444 for the latest information.


#### POINTS OF EMPHASIS

The skills of the players are to emphasized, not force and violence. All referees have been directed to become more of a factor in the games, if necessary, to help eliminate specific areas that detract from our American Youth Game.

- 2. Elbowing
- 3. Roughing
- 4. Cross checking
- 7. Checking from behind and late hits
- 8. Interference Hooking
- 9. Respect for the officials
