1979 OHIO PEEWEE TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1. Playing Rules. The official AHAUS playing rules shall be in effect except as noted below.
- 2. Timing the Game. Regulation play will consist of three 12-minute periods of stop time. Penalties will be minor (2 minutes), major (5 minutes) and misconduct (10 minutes). If the score is tied at the end of regulation time, a ten (10) minute sudden death overtime period shall be played in running time. If a goal is not scored in the overtime period, the winner will be determined by shots on goal for all three periods plus the overtime period.

three periods plus the overtime period.

NOTE: A shot on goal is defined as any shot that would have entered the net had the goalie not have been there. The puck must be shot from inside the center Red Line to be considered a shot on goal.

- 3. Team Rosters. Teams shall consist of a maximum of eighteen (18) players and no substitution for any player shall be allowed after the start of tournament play. Two (2) players must be dressed as goalers.
- 4. Team Registration. Teams must be properly registered with AHAUS.
- 5. Player Registration. Players must be registered with AHAUS.
- 6. Tournament Registration. The coach or manager must check in with the Tournament Marshall one hour before their first game. Each team is required to furnish a copy of their Players Registration Form that has been certified by the District Registrar. The Tournament Marshall must inspect each player's birth certificate in order for the player to be eligible to play. A current photograph of the player may be requested as further proof by Tournament Marshall. The score sheet lineup must be filled out at this time.
- 7. Player Check-In. Teams must be present no later than 45 minutes before game time. Teams must be on the ice at the designated times or warm-up will be forfeited. When the officials are ready to start the game, both teams will be ready or a forfeit will result.
- 8. Player's Bench. Only team players and a maximum of two team officials will be permitted on player's bench.
- 9. Captain and Alternate. The referee or official scorer shall be advised prior to the start of each game the name of the captain of the team and the player who will serve as alternate captain when the captain is off the ice.
- 10. <u>Fighting.</u> Any fighting in competition will mean that the player or players determined by the referee as involved will automatically receive a game misconduct penalty with a one game suspension.
- 11. Play-Off Suspensions. A player receiving any combination of two misconduct, game misconduct, or gross misconduct penalties shall be suspended from further play in the tournament. A player receiving a match penalty shall be suspended from further tournament play.

- 12. Conduct of Coaches and Managers. Any coach, manager or trainer being guilty of misconduct, game misconduct or gross misconduct penalties shall be suspended for the next game of his team. Physical abuse of officials will result in suspension from the tournament.
- 13. Profane Language. Profane language will not be tolerated from players or team officials. Any profanity will be dealt with severely. Parents or fans using profanity will be removed from the arena.
- 14. Protests. No protests shall be permitted.
- 15. Uniform Colors. The visiting team shall have first choice as to the color of uniforms they will wear.
- 16. Equipment and players participating in this tournament must wear equipment that meets AHAUS requirements. No exceptions.
- 17. Game Officials. Referees will be certified officials and will be assigned by the AHAUS Referee Supervisor for this area.
- 18. Admissions. Spectator fees will be \$2.00 for adults and \$1.00 for students 12 years and under per day. Weekend tournament passes will be available at \$5.00 for adults and \$2.00 for students. There is no charge for children 6 years old or younger. Tournament passes will be provided at registration for the players and three (3) team officials.
- 19. Medical Assistance. First aid will be available at the arena. Emergency equipment will be on call for any major injury.
