
enjoying every eye-watering second of it.







AHAUS: Designed To Help You

AHAUS. Many of you have seen these letters stamped across patches, pins and instructional manuals. They represent the "Amateur Hockey Association of the United States", the governing body for all amateur ice hockey in this country.

Along with being the national governing body for amateur ice hockey, the AHAUS is the official representative to the United States Olympic Committee and the International Ice Hockey Federation. In these roles, the AHAUS is responsible for organizing and training teams for international competition, whether it be a world tournament or the Olympics. It also coordinates activities with other national ice hockey federations around the world and, closer to home, works with the National Hockey League on matters of mutual interest.

However, those programs are just a small part of the AHAUS. The real purpose of the association is to administrate a well-organized youth sports program for those interested in playing amateur ice hockey in this country. Its goals are to educate participants, administrators, parents, coaches, officials, fans and others in the game of ice hockey while encouraging more people to become involved in the program.

The AHAUS is divided into eleven registration districts throughout the United States. Each district has a Registrar to register teams, a Referee-In-Chief to register officials and organize clinics and a Coaching Program Director to administrate an educational program.

For the player, the AHAUS conducts annual regional and national championships in various age classifications, sponsors regional and national summer camps for Midget-age players at the United States Olympic Training Center, studies and makes recommendations for protective equipment, distributes Hat Trick, Playmaker and Zero Club awards, directs National Youth Hockey Week and provides an optional low-cost insurance plan.

For coaches and officials, the AHAUS conducts clinics and publishes training manuals through the Coaching Achievement Program and the Officiating Program. Both of these programs can enrich the knowledge of either a coach or official through careful study, training and examination. The AHAUS also promotes uniformity in playing rules and their interpretations.

The AHAUS has not forgotten parents either, providing these vital members of amateur hockey with a "Parents' Guide To Youth Hockey", which includes tips on buying equipment, rules of the game, their roles as parents and much, much more.

Finally, the AHAUS acts as a clearinghouse for information to assist local organizations find solutions to problems at the grass roots levels, and annually publishes an "Official Guide" of the AHAUS By-Laws, Constitution, Rules and Regulations, Board of Directors, Officers, Affiliate Associations and Staff.
