## **TOURNAMENT RULES**

The 1988 Ottawa Capitals Summer Hockey Tournament welcomes teams competing in 9 age categories. All teams will play at least 5 games.

#### QUALIFICATION

All teams must provide a photocopy of a birth certificate or CAHA registration or other proof of age for each player. Failure to produce such proof of age at the tournament headquarters prior to his first game will result in the player being ineligible to play.

If a team has registered an ineligible player, that team will be automatically disqualified and the tournament Executive reserves the right to take whatever action as to the fate of a team defeated by a disqualified team, as well as the manner in which the tournament will continue. A player whose team has been so eliminated may not play for another team in the tournament.

An "underage" player may play for a team (e.g. a minor peewee may play for a major peewee team). A player may be registered to play for two teams in different age divisions if he fulfills age eligibility requirements.

## DIVISIONS AND GAME SCHEDULES

Six Team Divisions: Each team will play each of the other five teams once. Teams will then be ranked. In the semi-final round 1st place plays 4th place, 2nd place plays 3rd place. Winners advance to the championship game.

**Seven Team Divisions:** Each team will play each of the other six teams once. Teams will then be ranked. The 1st and 2nd place teams will advance to the champion-ship game.

**Eight Team Divisions:** There will be two groups of 4 teams each (Group A and Group B). Each team in each group will play each of the other teams in its group once. Teams will then be ranked.

Each team will then play 2 more games against teams in the other group, as follows:

1st place plays 3rd & 4th place teams of the other group. 2nd place plays 3rd & 4th place teams of the other group. 3rd place plays 1st & 2nd place teams of the other group. 4th place plays 1st & 2nd place teams of the other group.

After five games, 4 teams (regardless of group) advance to the semi-final round. 1st place plays 4th place and 2nd place plays 3rd place. Winners advance to the champion-ship game.

Ten Team Divisions: There will be two groups of 5 teams each (Group A and Group B). Each group will play a round robin (4 games each). Based on the results of the round robin, the teams within each group will be ranked from 1st to 5th place. Each team will then play one more game against a team in the other group, as follows:

Group A		Group B
#1	VS.	#4
#2	VS.	#3
#3	VS.	#2
#4	VS.	#1
#5	VS.	#5

After 5 games the top 2 teams in each group will advance to semi-final round. In the semi-final round: Group A 1st place plays Group B 2nd place and Group A 2nd place plays Group B 1st place. The winners advance to the championship game.

Twelve Team Divisions: There will be two groups: Group A with 6 teams and Group B with 6 teams. Each team will play every other team in their group (5 games each). The top two teams in each group will advance to the semi-final round. In the semi-final round:

Group A 1st place vs. Group B 2nd place; Group B 1st place vs. Group A 2nd place.

The winners of the semi-final games will advance to the championship game.

Fourteen Team Divisions: There will be a six team division (Group A) and a eight team division (Group B). In the six team division, each team will play each of the other five teams once. The top two teams will advance to the semi-finals. In the eight team division, there will be two groups of four teams each. Each team in each group will play each of the other teams in its group once. Teams will then be ranked. Each team will play two more games against teams in the other group as follows:

1st plays 3rd & 4th of the other group. 2nd plays 3rd & 4th of the other group. 3rd plays 1st & 2nd of the other group. 4th plays 1st & 2nd of the other group.

Based on the standings after the five games, the top two teams will advance to the semi-final.

In the semi-final the top team in Group A will play the 2nd place team in Group B and the 2nd place team in Group A will play the top team in Group B.

The two winners will advance to the championship game.

Sixteen Team Divisions: There will be two groups of 5 teams each (Group A and Group B). Each group will play a round robin (4 games each). Based on the results of the round robin, the teams within each group will be ranked from 1st to 5th place. Each team will then play one more game against a team in the other group as follows:

Group A		Group B
#1	VS.	#4
#2	VS.	#3
#3	VS.	#2
#4	VS.	#1
#5	VS	#5

Based on the standings after 5 games, Group A & Group B semi-finalists will be declared.

There will be one group of 6 teams (Group C). Each team will play each of the other five teams once. Based on the standings after 5 games, the Group C semi-finalist will be declared. The fourth semi-finalist will be the team with the best record of non-division winners (wild card winner).

In the semi-final, Group A winner plays Group C winner and Group B winner plays the wild card winner. If the wild card team comes from Group B, then Group A will play Group B and Group C will play the wild card team.

The two semi-final winners will advance to the championship game.

#### GAME TIMES

All games, both preliminary round and championship

games will be stop time. There will be no overtime in preliminary round, quarter-final or semi-final games. Games must start 5 minutes after the scheduled time (see "warm-up"). Teams must be ready to play 10 minutes before their scheduled game time.

All games will start on time. A maximum amount of time will be allowed to play a game (see table below). The game will end with completion of the allotted time at the arena managers discretion regardless of the score or remaining "stop" time.

The following table describes the total time (including ice floods) allotted to play a game:

Warm-ups: The warm-up will be a maximum of 5 minutes and will be determined by the Referee.

Ice Floods: The ice will be flooded at the end of the 2nd period or after every two periods, at the discretion of the arena manager. When the teams return to the ice following an ice flood, the starting lines must immediately prepare for a face-off and the remaining players must go to the bench.

Mercy Rule: A "Mercy Rule" will be applied in all games (preliminary and finals) as follows:

- 1. If 6 or more goals separate the teams at the end of the second period, or at any time in the third period, running time will commence and will not revert back to stop time.
- If 8 or more goals separate the teams at the end of the second period, or at any time in the third period, the game will end and will be awarded to the team with the 8 goal lead.
- Note: If a game is running straight time for reasons other than the "Mercy Rule", the last two minutes of the game must be stop time.

#### TEAM RANKING & TIE-BREAKER

#### A. Preliminary round, quarter-final and semifinal games:

Teams will be awarded 2 points for a win, 1 point for a tie, and 0 points for a loss. There will be no overtime in preliminary round, quarter-final or semi-final games. In the event of a tie for a position at the end of the preliminary round, quarter-final or semi-final games the following rules shall apply:

- 1. The winner of the game between the two tied teams in the preliminary round will earn the higher position.
- In the case of a three way tie, any team which has defeated the other two teams shall earn the higher position.
- 3. If the teams did not play each other in the preliminary round or are still tied after (1) & (2) then, the team with the

most wins over an equal number of games earns the higher position.

4. If the teams are still tied after (1) and (2) & (3) have been applied, the team with the best goal average will earn the higher position. The goal average is to be determined by dividing the total number of "goals for" plus "goals against", into the "goals for", and team having the highest percentage (two decimal places) will earn the higher position.

- 5. If the teams are still tied after (1), (2), (3), & (4) have been applied, the team which scored the first goal in the last game between the two teams will earn the higher position (if only two teams are tied).
- 6. If the teams are still tied after (1), (2), (3), (4), & (5) have been applied, then the team which received the lowest average penalty minutes per game in the preliminary round will earn the higher position.
- 7. If still tied, the winner of a single coin toss will earn the higher position.

**Note:** If at any step in breaking a three way tie, one team can be eliminated, it is eliminated and the remaining two way tie is broken in descending order beginning at step one.

#### B. Championship Games:

In the event of a tie in a championship game at the end of regulation play, sudden death overtime will begin immediately after the third period. The teams will change ends and play 10 minute overtime periods, changing ends without a break after each overtime period, until a goal is scored.

#### OFFICIALS

Minor Tyke, Major Tyke & Minor Atom - two referees Major Atom, Peewee, Bantam & Midget - one referee and two linesmen

Championship Games - one referee and two linesmen

#### RULES

CAHA Rules and the ODMHA Code of Discipline will apply. The "no body checking" rule will apply to Minor Tyke, Major Tyke and Minor Atom teams only.

### EXCERPTS FROM THE CODE OF DISCIPLINE:

#### 1. FIGHTING

A MAJOR PENALTY PLUS A GAME MISCONDUCT PENALTY SHALL BE ASSED TO ANY PLAYER WHO FIGHTS.

1ST FIGHT (including automatic game misconduct) - 1 Game Suspension (next game);

2ND FIGHT (including automatic game misconduct)2 Game Suspension (next 2 games);

3RD FIGHT (including automatic game misconduct)

- 3 Game Suspension (next 3 games);

Note: Any player who is identified by the Referee as being the instigator of, or aggressor in a FIGHT shall be assessed an additional one game suspension to that received for the infractions stated above. Any player who is assessed an automatic Game Misconduct penalty for FIGHTING in the last 10 minutes of the game (including OT), shall receive an additional one game suspension.

If the offence occurs in the last 10 minutes of a game in which the "Mercy Rule" is invoked, the additional game does not apply.

For all MATCH PENALTIES assessed:

1ST OFFENCE - three games (next 3 games); 2ND OFFENCE - automatic suspension from tournament.

If a fight occurs, both teams must proceed immediately to their own players' bench or to a neutral zone designated by the referee. The penalty for a violation of this rule is a game misconduct to the offending player(s).

#### 2. GAME MISCONDUCT

#### A. PLAYER(S)

Excluding the automatic Game Misconduct given to any player who FIGHTS, a player shall be suspended as follows:

1st, 2nd, 3rd OFFENCES - 1 game suspension (next game).

#### B. TEAM OFFICIAL(S):

1ST OFFENCE: 1 game (next game). 2ND OFFENCE: 3 games (next 3 games).

## 3. GROSS MISCONDUCT - PLAYER OR TEAM OFFICIAL:

1ST OFFENCE - three games (next 3 games); 2ND OFFENCE - five games (next five games).

#### 4. MATCH PENALTIES:

For all match penalties assessed: 1ST OFFENCE - three games (next 3 games); 2ND OFFENCE - automatic suspension from tournament

Checking from behind - a minor or major penalty for boarding or charging, at the discretion of the referee, shall be assessed to any player who intentionally pushes, body checks or hits an opposing player, in any manner, from behind, anywhere on the ice surface.

The starting lineup rule has been waived.

#### **PENALTIES**

All penalties are of the same duration whether during stop time or running time.

Minor Penalty - 2 minutes Major Penalty - 5 minutes

Misconduct Penalty - 10 minutes

Game Misconduct Penalty - remainder of the game plus must sit out the following game. (See Code of Discipline)

#### COMPOSITION OF TEAMS

A maximum of 21 players, nineteen skaters plus a regular goaltender and his alternate, are permitted to dress for a game. A minimum of 12 players, including the goaltender are required to start a game. Only players registered on the official tournament registration form are permitted to dress and play during the tournament.

Teams may register eligible players up to the time of their first game. No players can be added after the team's first game.

Any player who is under suspension shall not be eligible to play in this tournament during his suspension.

#### ALTERNATE GOALTENDER

Only 2 minutes will be allowed for the goaltender to recover from an injury. After 2 minutes he will be replaced immediately. If play is stopped for a player (except a goaltender) who is apparently or actually injured, he must leave the ice until after play is resumed.

#### TEAM COLOURS

When team colours are similar, the tournament officials will decide which team will wear a sweater of contrasting colour. It is preferable that each team have two sets of sweaters.

#### DRESSING ROOMS

Only registered players, team officials and tournament officials will be allowed in team dressing rooms. Dressing rooms must be vacated within 15 minutes after a game.

#### MANDATORY EQUIPMENT

Helmets and full face masks are compulsory. For Canadian teams they must be CSA approved. American teams will come under their own code as far as face masks are concerned.

#### GAME PROTESTS

Protests must be written on a form provided by the arena manager and submitted with a non-refundable deposit of \$25.00, by a team official at the arena tournament office within one hour after the end of the game. The decision of the Tournament Committee will be final. No protest will be entertained against referees' decisions or regarding a player whom the protesting team knew was ineligible prior to the game.


#### HANDSHAKE

There will be no handshake after the game.

There will be a delayed off-side rule for Midget & Bantam.


