# "84" PREVIEW

BRICK — The sound of pucks crashing off the boards and skates meeting ice in the middle of the summer may be perplexing to some, but to the players and organizers of the Garden State Games Ice Hockey Tournament, the sights and sounds filling the Ocean Ice Palace are indeed welcome.

There are 80 players, including 27 returning veterans, taking part in the second annual tournament. For the players, the tournament represents the final stage of a long journey. To secure a spot on one of the four regional teams taking part, each player had to successfully complete a challenging try-out. For the organizers, the time and effort leading up to the tournament was both considerable and successful.

"What we've tried to structure is a system similar to the National Sports Festival," Jim Plunkett, the tournament director, said. "We wanted a varsity coach to work with an AHAUS coach."

Plunkett has succeeded in procuring some of the best coaching talent available for the tournament.

Dan May, a long-time member of the New Jersey Rockets program, will coach Team North, while Steve Dagdigian, the head hockey coach at The Peddie School, will coach Team East. For Team South, Bruce Delventhal, the new head coach at Rochester Institute of Technology will be the coach. Delventhal had been an assistant coach at Princeton before moving to RIT. Team West will be under the direction of John Warchol, a former recipient of the New Jersey Chapter of the Professional Hockey Writers' Association's award for service to New Jersey hockey.

The coaches had to review a rather large group of hopefuls who turned out for try-outs at the four regional sites. Players who were residents of New Jersey and who had at least one year of high school eligibility remaining qualified for the tournament.

When all the try-outs were finished, 27 players landed spots on teams for the second straight year.

There are 10 returning players on Team East, the winner of last year's tournament. Rodney Pritchard of Fair Haven and Scott Doherty of Brick are a pair of standout forwards who should aid Team East's chances on offense. In last year's tournament, Pritchard had a pair of goals and three assists in four tournament games.

The East will also have a solid tandem in net as Erin Kirn and Todd Tessmer, both from Brick, take to the goal crease for a second year. Kirn was nearly unbeatable in goal for Team East last year, allowing five goals in two games.

Team West, last year's runner-up, returns three players with experience in the tournament. Arin Krich of Convent Station emerged as the leading goaltender

last year, posting a 2.00 goals-against average.

Dan Prachar of Iselin and Michael Haviland of Leonardo are two competent offensive players who should be able to complement Krich's fine goaltending. Last year, Prachar had three goals, making him the leading goal scorer returning to the tournament.

Team North will have nine experienced players in the lineup for the tournament. Leading the way for the North is Don Distasio of Mendham, one of three defensemen to notch three points in the 1983 tournament. Lodi's Jim Elia, a forward who scored a pair of goals and two assists for Team West last year, will certainly help bolster Team North's offense this time around

Tom Jenkinson of Audubon Park and Michael Black of Cherry Hill will lead Team South. Jenkinson was one of the 1983 tournament's top four scorers, having accumulated six assists and 13 shots on goal last year. Black had three goals in 1983 and added two assists.

In addition to the fine talent on display from a players' standpoint, the tournament features a solid corps of officials who have made it a success off the ice.

The New Jersey Devils' highly competent corps of off-ice officials will again act as scorekeepers, penalty box time keepers and goal judges. This group is under the direction of Dick Trimble.

The referees and linesmen in the tournament will also be among the best available.

"The referees will be AHAUS members from the area and they're an elite group," Plunkett said. "They've all done well in the Sports Festival. They're probably tops in the country. Over the past couple of years, 30 to 50 percent of the officials (in hockey) in the Sports Festival have been from this area."

Included in the group of officials who will be aiding the tournament are two men with professional experience. Jim Doyle, the assistant tournament director, has been a referee in the American and Central hockey leagues, as well as a member of the National Hockey League's Cadet Officials Training Program. Pat Dapuzzo, a North Bergen resident, and one of the top linesmen in the AHL, as well as a top prospect for the NHL, will serve as a supervisor of officials.

"We've set up a structure where there's a league supervisor and a referee in chief, so the officials are supervised closely," Plunkett said. "In the past, it's worked well."

The tournament serves as a showcase for New Jersey's amateur hockey talent and several college coaches are expected to be scout the action.

## OFFICIATING AT THE GARDEN STATE GAMES

by Vin Godleski, AHAUS - Referee - In - Chief

As the level of Ice Hockey competition increases the need for quality officials increases. The efforts for the officials to keep pace with players development are as dilligent as the players and their coaches.

If the officials (and the teams) are doing a good job you'll never pay much attention to the referee and linesmen. We hope that will be the case this year. But if you do stop to watch them for a line shift or during a time out you probably won't see the "same old faces".

It has been my policy as Referee-in-Chief of the Atlantic District to use the best, most enthuastic young officials possible. This has worked out well in the vast majority of the tournament, mid-season and playoff games where we have appointed a junior official in place of a proven veteran.

Jim Doyle and Pat Dapuzzo, now both proven officials in Professional and ECAC College hockey "got their first break" that way. Now we are looking for the new quality officials to follow along with them.

Training, supervision and experience rare the keys for development of an official. The AHAUS Officials Program provides these.

Training: Local and National Camps, Schools anso clinics are conducted throughout the season. Every district Official must attend a clinic each year. This gives them an opportunity to brush up on the rules, get in shape and improve their skating. National Summer Camps are held for the top young prospects. The past two seasons the Atlantic District has had the largest representation of any AHAUS District.

Supervision: Each game in the Garden State Games will be supervised by a game supervisor. It is their job to provide effective feedback to the on-ice officials. These supervisors will share their observations with the games officials either between periods or after the game, which ever they judge will be most effective. They and the game Referee-in-Chief are the only ones who talk with the game officials before the game or between periods.

A game Referee-in-Chief is also at the penalty bench during every game. The referee on the ice is in full charge and his decisions and actions are final. However, the game Referee-in-Chief's job is to provide an additional resource for the referee if the referee choses to use him to answer questions, relay directions or help him get things done with the rink crew or teams. From experience they have helped the on-ice officials often.

The competition to participate in the Garden State Games is an intense one for the officials as it is for the players. Almost since the end of last season a large number of young men have been training and conditioning for the games.

Four Atlantic district referees participated in the AHAUS National Select Officials School held at Lake Placid in early July. These men were selected in a national wide competion for the 24 slots open. Using their new skills and experience gained at these National Camps to work during the games will be:

Murray Seltzer 21 Bricktown Student at Ocean County College and former Brick Juniors and High School Goaltender.

Eric Monroe 24 Budd Lake Graduate of Fairleigh Dickenson has Accounting practice in Summit.

Greg Bonaguria 18 Kendall Park will be a freshman this fall at Merrimack College, North Andover, Mass.

Eric Godleski 22 Lebanon, former Golden Blades and Norwich College defenseman now attends Somerset College and is President of E & K Services, a local construction company.

Veteran officials and assignments will be announced.

### MEDAL ROUND TO BE SEEN VIA CABLE VISION

Not only will participants in the 1984 Garden State Games Hockey Tournament gain exposure to numerous college coaches and professional scouts, but for the second consecutive year, their play will be scrutinized by New Jersey's cable television viewers as well.

Later this summer, Trenton's Cable Television Network of New Jersey (CTN), in conjunction with Shamrock Sports of Yardley, Pennsylvania, will utilize an extensive network of cable systems to bring the tournament's Gold and Bronze medal games to virtually the entire state of New Jersey. The Bronze medal game will be aired Monday, August 13th, and the Gold medal game may be seen a week later, Monday, August 20th, with both matches being carried in the8-9:30 P.M.time slot.

CTN, through 31 separate outlets, has the capacity to reach approximately one million homes, linking 96 percent of New Jersey's cable systems throughout 450 municipalities. It is the first state-wide cable television network in the nation.

The production and play-by-play broadcast of the games will be handled by New Jersey Network's Pat Scanlon. Jim Plunkett, the tournament's director, will provide the color commentary. Plunkett is also the Atlantic District's Coaching Program Director for the Amateur Hockey Association of the United States (AHAUS).
